

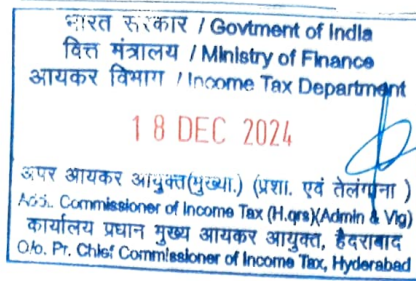

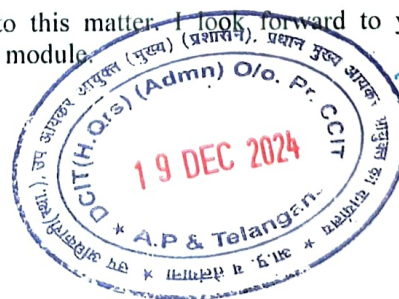
I would like to draw your attention to the Government of India's important initiative to roll out the electronic Bill System (e-Bill) as part of the Public Finance Management System (PFMS) across the country. Launched by the Hon'ble Union Minister for Finance & Corporate Affairs on 2nd March 2022, and announced in the Union Budget for 2022-23, the e-Bill system is a key component of the Government's 'Ease of Doing Business' and 'Digital India' initiatives. It aims to streamline public financial management, enhance transparency, and expedite payment processing.

The Ministry of Finance has recently issued instructions that the e-Bill system must be fully implemented across all Ministries and Departments by the end of this financial year. In this regard, the O/o Principal Chief Controller of Accounts (Pr.CCA), CBDT is overseeing the implementation of the e-Bill module within the Commissionerate/ field units of Central Board of Direct Taxes (CBDT). To ensure a smooth transition, guidance has been provided to all Zonal Accounts Offices (ZAOs) to support and coordinate the efforts of Drawing and Disbursing Officers (DDOs) in adopting the e-Bill system.

While some DDOs in regions such as Nagpur and Panchkula have successfully implemented the e-Bill module, progress in other regions has been slower. Given the importance of this system in achieving greater efficiency and transparency in financial processes, I kindly seek your intervention and cooperation in prioritizing the adoption of the e-Bill system across all field formations under your jurisdiction. It is crucial that Heads of Offices/DDOs work closely with their respective ZAOs to facilitate a smooth and uniform transition.

Attached to this letter, you will find the necessary Standard Operating Procedure (SOP) to guide the process. Your cooperation and timely action in this matter are vital to ensuring the seamless and efficient adoption of the e-Bill system, contributing to the broader goal of improving digital payment systems across all government formations.

Thank you for your attention to this matter. I look forward to your support in ensuring the successful implementation of the e-Bill module.
